### My Eighth Tradition Checklist ...

1. Is my own behavior accurately described by the Traditions? If not, what needs changing?
2. When I chafe about any particular Tradition, do I realize how it affects others?
3. Do I sometimes try to get some reward — even if not money — for my personal AA efforts?
4. Do I try to sound like an AA expert on Alcoholism? On recovery? On medicine?

On sociology?" On AA itself? On psychology? On spiritual matters? Or,  
heaven help me, even on humility?



5. Do I make an effort to understand what AA employees do? What  
workers in other alcoholism agencies do? Can I distinguish clearly be-  
tween them?

6. In my own AA like, have I any experiences to illustrate the wisdom  
of this Tradition?

7. Have I paid enough attention to the book Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions? To the pam-  
phlet AA Tradition — How It Developed?
